Hi, everybody and welcome to online Math 3304 The course is semi-self-paced. You do have popper deadlines and homework deadlines, and, of course tests in CASA testing by appointment during given days.

Each of the 5 modules has a homework assignment plus pop quizzes embedded in the videos. As you view the video, I stop lecturing occasionally and ask a multiple choice question. You record your answers under the emcf tab in your CourseWare account by the deadline. The poppers are due on a Friday and the homework is due on a Monday night. The following Thursday, I grade the Discussion Board.

In CourseWare (the url is on my website, if you don't have an account set one up quickly please), over on the upper left of the homepage is the Discussion Board link. This is the place to share good videos and answer questions and ask questions about the homework and the ideas in the video. This posting work is 10% of your grade and I grade them personally. One point for each content related post.

Last spring, about 32 posts was a B. This is two content related posts a week. So if you want an A, plan on doing 3 or 4 a week. Now saying thank you or setting up a study group, these are nice but not content related so no points for this kind of posting. Explaining a homework question to someone is definitely a point as is posting the url of a good video. Taking tests is in CASA Testing by appointment, if your photo and finger prints are not already on file, make arrangements to get them on file, please. Reservations can be made about 10 days before the test.
