Example 5: Find the domain of the functions.

$$g(x) = \frac{x+3}{x+4}$$

$$h(x) = \sqrt{24 - 8x}$$

Example 6: State whether the following lines are parallel, perpendicular, or neither.

$$y = 3x - 6$$
$$3x - y = 12$$

$$y - 4x = 9$$
$$y + \frac{x}{4} = 12$$

$$4y = 7x + 10$$
$$y - 6 = -\frac{4}{7}x$$
