

Scholarships Guidelines

Department of Mathematics

The Mathematics Department at the University of Houston administers two types of scholarships. One is available to incoming freshmen and the other to returning students.

The requirements for the incoming freshman scholarship are the following:

- 1) Student must show a strong interest in the area of Math and must have a proven record of success in all courses pertaining to this discipline.
- 2) Student must have selected Math as their Major.
- 3) A high GPA score in Math and a high overall GPA score is needed.

The requirements for the returning student scholarship are the following:

- 1) Student must be classified as a junior or a senior.
- 2) Student must have successfully completed at least 30 hours at the University of Houston.
- 3) Student must have a high GPA score in Math and a high overall GPA.

The Math Department Scholarship Committee is comprised of the following people:
