


Online Exam with Stand Alone CASA Monitor Student Instructions

Be sure you have the following setup:
PC or Mac computer with webcam.
IPAD, Chromebook, Cellphone, and other systems are **not supported**.
Chrome or Edge browser.
Other browsers are **not supported**.

If there's any issue during your exam, please capture a screen shot and email it, along with detail description of the error, to CASA Tech Support at courseware@uh.edu for assistance. You might want to write this email address now.

Later we will ask you to share your webcam and your screen.
If another app (say Teams) is using your webcam or screen, **you will have trouble**.
Check carefully that your webcam and screen are free.

See the start-up procedure at right.
After Step 12, and immediately before you start your exam:
1. Show your UH student ID to the webcam for 10 seconds.
2. If you are using scratch paper, show each side of each page for 10 seconds -- this is to prove they are blank.
3. If your instructor allows you to use a calculator, show the calculator for 10 seconds.

Follow the steps – there are 12 steps.


You must have a working webcam showing you and a bit of your surroundings.

You must agree to share the whole screen.

Be careful about sharing the screen - some browsers will pop up a drop down menu to find the “entire screen” option as in the image below:



AFTER STEP 12 – the CASA page will show up.



Show your ID to the camera for 10 seconds.

If you don't have a cougar ID, you can use another picture ID (Driver's License or State ID...).

You may use blank paper as a scratch paper. Show the pages to the camera at this point to prove that they are blank. Show each page (back and front) for 10 seconds.

Now, you can open a new window and log in to LYRYX.


Webcam must show your face at all times.

Work on the problems; stay on your desk, in front of the camera.

You are not allowed to take screenshots or pictures of questions while taking the exam. You are not allowed to open any new windows, or use any additional resources, such as calculators, phones, books, notes,...

Do not touch your phone while you are taking the exam, even to check the time. Time is displayed on your computer.

When you are done, submit your test in Lyryx. Before you start reading the feedback on your test, go back to CASA monitor and click on “I finished the test” to stop the CASA monitor. Do not stop the monitor before submitting your work!



You're done with the test. Go back to Lyryx and read their feedback on your exam.
