






Log in with your Cougarnet credentials.

You will need to enter the 5digit section number on the next page. Our section number: 15671 for 4331 and 15672 for 6312



Next, read the information on the page:



Follow the steps – there are 12 steps.


You must have a working webcam showing you and a bit of your surroundings.

You must agree to share the whole screen.

Be careful about sharing the screen - some browsers will pop up a drop down menu to find the "entire screen" option as in the image below:



AFTER STEP 12 - the CASA page will show up.



Show your ID to the camera for 10 seconds. If you don't have a cougar ID, you can use another picture ID (Driver's License or State ID...).

If you have blank paper because you can't print the test, show the pages to the camera at this point to prove that they are blank. Show each page (back and front) for 10 seconds.

Now, you can open Gradescope webpage and log in.


Find the test. Print it out; or work on it digitally. Webcam must show your face. See FAQ below after reading the rules.

NOTE: If your printer is in another room, show a page with a message to the webcam explaining why you're leaving the room. Get the test and come back to the desk ASAP.

Work on the problems; stay on your desk, in front of the camera.

You are not allowed to take screenshots or pictures of questions while taking the exam.

When you are done, submit your test on Gradescope. And then, click on "I finished the test" to stop the CASA monitor. Do not stop the monitor before submitting your work!
