

Hello all,

This is a reminder that the scheduler for Test 3 will open at midnight on Thursday, November 7 (the midnight between Wednesday evening and Thursday morning). The dates of the actual exam will be Thursday, November 21 through Saturday, November 23. Please schedule your exam as soon as the scheduler becomes available to you, so you are certain to get your preferred time slot.

A couple of reminders. First, enough testing slots will be made available for everyone taking the exam. If the slots are full when you try to schedule your test, keep trying. More time slots will become available up until the first day of the testing window. However, if you wait until the afternoon of the last day of the testing window to attempt scheduling your exam, you will not be able to sit for your test. There is no "stand-by" testing, and the testing center does not "have to" let you take your exam.

Second, I do not control the scheduling or operations of the testing center. Telling me to open more slots, asking me to allow you to reschedule or swap a time slot with a friend, or give you extended time because you are running late will not accomplish anything. All schedule changes, if possible, can be handled through the Proctored Exams tab in casa. If you miss your exam for any reason, you can reschedule if there are available slots remaining. Do whatever possible to make the appointment for your exam so you are not stuck hoping that an additional time slot opens up for you.

This exam will be entirely multiple choice, meaning that you will see your entire grade as soon as you are done taking the exam. The number of questions and point breakdown will be discussed during the exam review. Your highest score on Practice Test 3 will count as extra credit (5% will be added to your exam grade). These extra points cannot be transferred to other grades or "banked" for future exams. They will count only for this test. Regardless of the deadline for the Practice Test, do not complete it after you take your exam. As the name implies, it is practice for the test.

As before, you will be permitted a calculator, which you provide, for this exam. Make sure it is one that you are comfortable with the operation of.
