Accessing Information Through CASA

As Soon As Possible:

Purchase an Access code from the bookstore. Even though the deadline isn't for a few weeks, there are sometimes issues with inputting the code. You do not want to be locked out of the course. If you are, you will receive no credit for any assignments that expire before you regain access.

Complete Course Policy Quiz. This is located under the Online Assignment Tab in casa. You must complete it with a score of 100% before you access to the remaining quizzes and practice tests. Again, even though the deadline isn't for weeks, complete this quiz this week.

Course Notes:

The calendar on the main page of case will contain blank notes, and completed notes.

Blank notes will all be available by the first day of class.

Completed notes will be available after each lecture is completed.

Online Assignments:

Weekly quizzes and practice exams will be available in the online assignments tab (once you complete the course policy quiz).

Quizzes will have 20 attempts each. The lowest quiz grade will be dropped at the end of the semester.

Practice Exams will have 20 attempts each. 5% of your highest score will count as extra credit for that exam.

These must be submitted online through this tab. Late assignments will not be accepted.

Assignments Tab:

This will contain weekly written homeworks. Blank homework documents will be in this tab (as PDF) and in a link from the main casa page (DOCX and PDF).

Complete these assignments in writing, showing all work. (Screenshots of Rstudio or written calculator syntax are acceptable as work).

A link to the textbook is located on the main casa page to access those questions.

Scan your completed work as save as a single PDF document, then upload and submit. (You will notice a file appears in the Student Submission column).

Tips on Submitting Written Homework:

Write legibly. If we cannot read your work, you will not receive credit.

Documents must be scanned right-side up. Upside down, backwards, etc, documents will receive no credit.

Be on a wifi or hard-wired network when submitting. Data networks can be erratic and you may not submit correctly.

Do not wait until 11:50 to submit work due at 11:59. The system will be crowded and you may be kicked out. Submit work before 10:00pm to avoid this problem.

Once submitted, log out of casa, and then log back in to make sure your completed assignment is still there. (This will make sure there were no submission issues).

Be patient about grading. There are 1000 students taking this course in various sections. Reading these takes time. It can be 2-3 weeks before you see a grade. 2 homeworks will be dropped at the end of the semester.

Exams:

Exams are given in the testing center (located on campus).

These exams must be scheduled in from the Proctored Exams tab in casa. Schedule early. The slots will sometimes fill up, and I cannot open up more slots once this has happened.

Show up to your appointment early. If you are late to your exam, you will not be permitted to take it and may only reschedule if there are remaining slots available.

RStudio and the Casa Calculator will be provided for you on all exams. If you would like to provide your own calculator as well, you may do so.

EMCF (Electronic Multiple Choice Form):

This tab will not be used for this course.
